

**ELSINORE VALLEY MUNICIPAL WATER DISTRICT REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS  
LEE LAKE DAM UPGRADES - DESIGN AND ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES**

Elsinore Valley Municipal Water District is requesting proposals from qualified consultants for:

Lee Lake Dam Upgrades – Design and Environmental Services

The purpose of the Proposal is to demonstrate the qualifications, competence and capacity of Respondent to perform the work or provide the services described in this RFP. The Proposal should demonstrate the qualifications of the Respondent and of the particular staff to be assigned to this project.

The purpose of this RFP is to prepare all Contract Documents to comply with the Plan for the Lee Lake Dam Upgrades (Dam No. 818-2) submitted by EVMWD to the Department of Safety of Dams (DSOD), dated March 6, 2017. This plan has specific milestones that must be met. The critical milestone is the DSOD certification which must occur by September 2019 to ensure no additional permits such as the Emergency Action Plan by DWR are required for the facility.

A brief description of the main scope of work items is shown below:

1. Design the demolition of the Dam to bedrock and design a new berm to be constructed that will be below (i.e. outside) of DSOD jurisdictional limits;
2. Prepare a permanent scour design;
3. CEQA services for all of the services described above in order to construct the Lee Lake Dam Upgrades; and
4. Assist the District in securing all Engineering Permits required to construct the Lee Lake Dam Upgrades.

The Consultant must also provide Public Outreach services and describe the scope the Consultant deems necessary to gain consensus for the Project.
