Note 2: In the event that the product of a unit price and an estimated quantity does not equal the extended amount stated, the unit price will govern, and the correct product of the unit price and the estimated quantity shall be deemed to be the amount bid.

In the case of a tie, a tie bid will be broken by the following methods, in descending order of preference:

1. Request best and final costs;
2. By the flip of a coin in the presence of a minimum of three (3) witnesses;
3. Reject bids and re-bid.
